


WHY DO WE NEED INTERDENTAL BRUSHES (IDB)

- Daily toothbrushing is important in order to disorganize the plaque
- But a regular toothbrush can only reach the "easy-access" parts of a tooth
- Interdental spaces the tiny gaps between our teeth cannot be reached with a regular toothbrush
- The only way to clean these spaces is either with floss or specially designed tools
- 16 billion bacteria can live in one interdental site

Millions of people are yet to join the interdental cleaning revolution.

RISKS OF NOT **CLEANING INTERDENTAL SPACES**




- Bacteria will settle, thicken, and eventually turn to dangerous biofilm - plague
- A build-up of bacteria and plaque can cause halitosis (bad breath)
- Beside tooth decay plaque causes gum inflammation (gingivitis) which eventually turns to periodontitis which causes periodontal pockets and loss of bone
- A severe periodontitis can lead to tooth decay (caries), eventual tooth loss and other serious health problems

- When gums are inflamed, harmful bacteria gets into the bloodstream and can cause problems in the rest of the body
- There are strong links between poor oral health and serious diseases such as endocarditis, cardiovascular disease, complications during pregnancy, pneumonia and many more.







THE CORRECT TOOL, AND SIZE, MATTERS


Interdental brushes are the only tool capable of cleaning all bacteria from interdental spaces:

- Floss is not able to clean the critical places, such as the teeth concavities and col area between the papillae.
- Many interdental brushes do not have long-enough bristles to reach the critical places mentioned above.
- The bristles of Curaprox's IDBs have a so called umbrella effect: they band at the entrance of the interdental space and they stretch to fill the entire space. In this way one single in-andout movement is enough to properly cleaning the interdental space.
- Plus, the CURAL wire is extremely fine, yet extremely resistent, so it is perfect for even the smallest of interdental spaces.

HOW TO USE AN INTERDENTAL BRUSH CORRECTLY

- Place an IDB at the gum line between the teeth.
- Find the right entrance angle.
- Push the brush through with care and then pull it out – job done!
- So effective thanks to the ultrafine bristles with umbrella effect, that one single cleaning movement is enough.

ONCE A DAY: IN, OUT, DONE.











SOME FACTS ABOUT USING INTERDENTAL BRUSHES

- At first, a bit of bleeding is normal that shows there is inflammation.
- Continue caring for the gums with this routine every single day, and within a week, the inflammation and any bleeding should subside. If not – advice from a dental professional is needed.
- The size of your interdental spaces might change after some time. This is because swelling caused by the inflamation goes down.
- It doesn't matter whether an IDB is used before or after brushing your teeth.

- After use, just rinse with water and let dry. We advise not to put the cap on, because it is more hygienic.
- IDBs can be used approx. 7-10 days.
 No problem if the wire bends, just bend it back.
- For back teeth, the wire can be slightly bent, to get better reach.






CPS ORTHO -FOR BRACES

- CPS 18 is ideal for cleaning the wires, simply by inserting it underneath.












Your patient is ready to use their interdental brushes at home: give them one brush of each size needed. Simply place the brushes inside the flyer that explains how to use them correctly.








The chairside box is available for CPS prime and CPS perio.

Now, take the matching interdental brush from the chairside box.




INSERTION DIAMETER (ACCESSIBILITY):

The brush's access radius is defined by the wire core gauge in addition to the bristles bent on themselves during insertion: this is the umbrella effect.

CLEANING DIAMETER (EFFECTIVENESS):

The cleaning radius corresponds to the length of the filaments (in mm).






