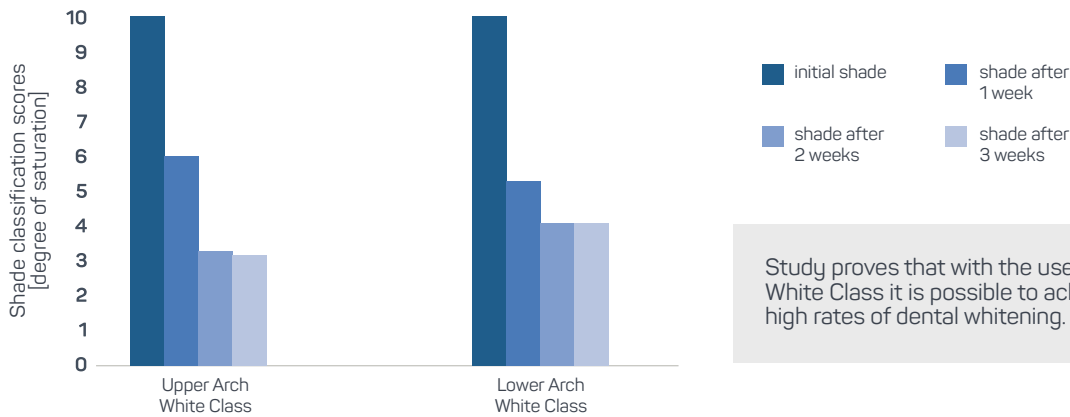

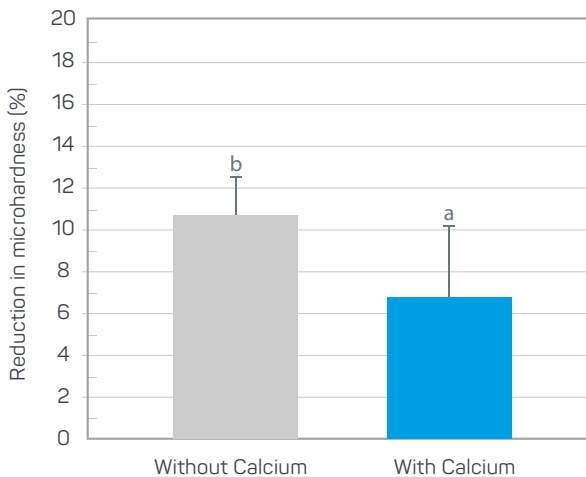
Shade changes at different times of the evaluation for the whitening agent in the upper and lower arches.
